

Proposed Amendments to the LNLA Bylaws

The LNLA Board of Directors recommend that the bylaws be amended to (1) allow the Annual Meeting of the Association to be held in the spring and (2) removal of the requirement for an educational program. The current bylaws state the meeting will be held in August. A spring meeting would provide all the members with current information about summer projects, upcoming social events and volunteers needed. The Annual Meetings may include an educational program but it does not need to be required.

Article V, Section 1 as adopted 8/14/2017

Annual Meeting: The Annual Meeting of the Association shall be held in the vicinity of Lower Nemahbin Lake in **August**. The date, time and place will be arranged by the Board of Directors, unless specified by the previous Annual Meeting. The agenda of the Annual Meeting shall include elections, discussion of projects, adoption of a budget, Member concerns, and an **educational program**. (Wis.Stat.,181.0701)

Article V, Section 1 revised as proposed by the Board, June 2023

Annual Meeting: The Annual Meeting of the Association shall be held in the vicinity of Lower Nemahbin Lake in **the spring**. The date, time and place will be arranged by the Board of Directors, unless specified by the previous Annual Meeting. The agenda of the Annual Meeting shall include elections, discussion of projects, adoption of a budget, and Member concerns. (Wis.Stat.,181.0701)
